Curriculum:

The course curriculum follows communicative approach to English language teaching, which means the students are encouraged to take the lead of their learning instead of relying exclusively on the teacher input.

In addition to the core curriculum, weekly practice sessions are conducted for reading and listening. During these sessions, students independently complete one or two sections of each subtest under the guidance of an expert trainer. This is followed by a thorough discussion of the answers selected by the students to facilitate reflection on their performance. A weekly speaking clinic is also held, focusing primarily on fluency practice. In these sessions, students practice with their peers under the trainer's supervision and receive feedback on areas for improvement.

For the test series section, students are encouraged to complete entire subtests in a single session, simulating actual test conditions. For the reading and listening subtests, detailed answers and explanations are provided to enable students to reflect on their performance using techniques taught during the practice sessions. For the writing subtest, comprehensive feedback is given on each student's strengths and weaknesses, along with raw scores. In the speaking subtest, personal tutorials are provided where an expert trainer assists students in preparing and performing role-plays, followed by verbal and written feedback on areas for improvement.

Mock tests are organized at the institute for candidates approaching their exam dates. These tests simulate exam conditions to help candidates prepare for the stress and challenges of exam day. The student portal is designed to replicate this experience for candidates taking the OET @home or OET on computer exams. Following the mock tests, an accurate prediction of scores is provided along with detailed feedback on areas for improvement.
